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## Antionette's bet for the Snow White pattern

1. using the pattern right, cut one out of leather or fabric that doesn't fray such as vinyl or ultra suede.
2. press a small piece of stiff interfacing to the pointed end of the belt if your leather is soft. If your leather or fabric is stretchy fuse the whole belt.
3. Thread buckle on to end of belt and glue in place. Dotted line is where the belt folds over the inside of the buckle.
4. Below is a picture of the buckle I used, you can see the inside diameter is  $5/16$ , if your buckle has a different i.d. then just trim the belt pattern down a little before you cut..
5. This will be easier to cut if you use a rotary cutter and cut thru the paper and fabric at the same time.
