


Shoe for Marley/Alice/Agnes

Right Shoe



Left Shoe



Directions:

- 1. Cut shoe top and sole out of lightweight non-fraying fabric or glove leather along solid lines. Then cut small notches in the top shoe as indicated by the zig-zag lines. This will reduce the bulk when gluing to the insole.
- 2. Overlap top of shoe at back matching to the dotted line. Sew or glue in place.
- 3. Cut the insole of heavy cardboard. Glue notched tabs to the bottom of insole piece. I found that I need to make another insole of light weight paper after shoe was finished to clean up the inside. Let glue dry for several hours.
- 4. Glue sole to bottom of shoe, pressing firmly and keeping sole flat. Let dry. Note: I used the foot of my doll while glueing all pieces. It was easier to wrap the tabs around the insole with the parts on the doll. I used Sobo glue, and wrapper her foot in plastic wrap.
