Shoe for Marley/Alice/Agnes

## Directions:

1. Cut shoe top and sole out of lightweight non-fraying fabric or glove leather along solid lines. Then cut small notches in the top shoe as indicated by the zig-zag lines. This will reduce the bulk when gluing to the insole.

2. Overlap top of shoe at back matching to the dotted line. Sew or glue in place.

3. Cut the insole of heavy cardboard. Glue notched tabs to the bottom of insole piece. I found that I need to make another insole of light weight paper after shoe was finished to clean up the inside. Let glue dry for several hours.

4. Glue sole to bottom of shoe, pressing firmly and keeping sole flat. Let dry.

Note: I used the foot of my doll while glueing all pieces. It was easier to wrap the tabs around the insole with the parts on the doll. I used Sobo glue, and wrapper her foot in plastic wrap.
