

Beret

You will need a scrap of fashion fabric big enough to cut two of the above circles. I used Velveteen, but wool and wool blends would also be nice.

You will also need a scrap of lining fabric big enough to cut 1 circle.

Cutting

Cut 1 circle from the fashion fabric.

Cut 1 circle from the fashion fabric and lining fabric, and then cut out the center circle colored in gray.

Sewing

With right sides together match the lining and fabric circles with the centers cut out and sew around the inside circle. Clip all around the inside edges, then then pull the lining to the wrong side of the hat bottom, and press.

Baste the lining to the hat bottom around the outside edge.

Match the hat bottom to the hat top with right sides together and pin or baste in place. Sew around the outside edge of the hat.

Serge the seam to clean finish. Turn hat right side out and press.
